
Cleveland Indians Special Edition

This year the Cleveland Indians home opener will be on **April 10th** against the Detroit Tigers. Cleveland Indians

The Early Years:

- Professional baseball in Cleveland began June 2, 1869 when the Cleveland Forest Citys met the Cincinnati Red Stockings
- April 24, 1901, Cleveland's American League franchise reached it's 100th anniversary on of just four Charter A.L. clubs, along with: Chicago, Boston, and Detroit
- In 1914, Cleveland franchise renamed their team: Cleveland Naps to the Cleveland Indians
- Cleveland Indians won their first World Series in 1920, at League Park against the Brooklyn Dodgers
- Indians began to play at the new Cleveland Municipal Stadium on July 31, 1932



The Glory Years:

- Bob Feller launched the 1940 season with a no-hitter against the White Sox in Chicago
- 1946, Bob Feller was the forefront of big league pitchers, leading the majors with 26 wins and a club record of 348 strikeouts
- Cleveland Indians win World Series in 1948, beating the Boston Braves in six games

Trying Times:

- The Cleveland Indians led the A.L. in home runs in 1959. Tribe home attendance was up 125%
- On October 3, 1974, Executive Vice President of the Indians Ted Bonda introduced Frank Robinson as the first black manager in MLB history

Renewed Glory:

- April 4, 1994, *Jacobs Field* was the new home to the Cleveland Indians
- The Cleveland Indians qualified for the World Series in 1995, the first time since 1954
- In 1997, the Indians hosted the 1997 World Series, however lost to the Florida Marlins in seven games
- Jim Thome hit the longest home run in Jacobs Field history, with a 511 feet hit to center field
- The Jacobs era of Indians baseball ended in February 2000, when Lawrence Dolan and family bought the Cleveland Indians



Present Day:

- Jacobs Field was renamed to Progressive Field in 2008
- Designated hitter Travis Hafner belted his 200th home run as a member of the Indians, putting him eighth on the franchise's all-time home run list in 2012
- 2013, Terry Francona's first season as Cleveland's manager
- Cleveland hosted the AL Wild Card game, but was defeated by Tampa Bay in 2013. Tribe's first trip to the playoffs since 2007

With a clean slate, there is hope for a great season of baseball with the Cleveland Indians. Go Tribe!
