Medicating Difficult Pets

Most animals will not take a pill and some learn to spit them out even if they are hidden in food. Often after a few barely successful attempts they will learn to run and hide at the sound of the prescription vial opening. This can lead to your pet not getting the medication he or she needs to be happy and healthy.

For cats, we can also take some of the commonly used medications and make it into a gel that is rubbed onto the ear of the cat. **Cats have a lot of blood supply in their ears, which makes transdermal drug delivery a great option.** Your feline friend won't even know they are getting medication! Do's

- Ask permission to pet an animal before approaching
- Let the pet sniff you (this is like shaking hands)
- Be gentle and approach slowly

Don'ts

- Pull on ears, tails, or paws
- Hug or tease
- Pet while eating, sleeping, or chewing on a bone or toy

Making sure you are up to date on your vaccinations is important. Here at Sand Run Pharmacy, we can help! Did you know we can give all of the following vaccinations:

- Influenza
- Pneumonia (Pneumovax 23 and Prevnar 13)
- Meningococcal (Menactra and Trumenba)
- Hepatitis A and B
- Tetanus and Diphtheria (Td) booster
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)
- Shingles (Zostavax)

We are able to vaccinate patients as young as 7 years old. Call us anytime for more information regarding rules and recommendations for different vaccinations.
